

About REACH Services

The REACH Center advocates for the needs of survivors of crime, assault, and abuse. We promote crime prevention with education and information throughout our communities.

Advocacy

Advocates are available to meet with survivors and provide guidance, emotional support, and coordination of services.

They act as a liaison between the survivor and collaborating agencies, forming your bridge to wellbeing. The advocates also provide accompaniments to legal, medical, and other necessary appointments.



Crisis Counseling & Therapy

Licensed Mental Health providers and trained counselors provide individual and group-based services to support those impacted by crime and abuse.

Therapists are trained in evidence based treatments and will work with the survivor to choose the right one to meet individual needs.

Crime Victim's Compensation Assistance

We provide assistance completing the New York State Office of Victim Services (NYS OVS) compensation application. NYS OVS is a program dedicated to helping provide financial assistance and reimbursement to victims of crime.

24 Hour Helpline

Our helpline services are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to provide support to survivors of crime, assault, or abuse. Call: 518.943.4482.

The helpline services are provided by staff and volunteers who are trained to provide crisis counseling via phone and accompaniments for medical and legal emergencies.
